****NEW RENEWAL DATES****

Upon implementation of a new eLicensing system, Arizona liquor licenses will renew one year from the date of issuance. For example, if your license was issued on November 12, 2005, the new renewal date will be the last day of November 2010 and every November 30th thereafter. Half-year license applications and renewals will no longer be available. This applies to all license types. The eLicensing system upgrade is expected to occur in June 2010.

During the next twelve (12) months, you will receive a pro-rated renewal notice reflecting fees due. Fees will include the months which have passed between the month your license was last renewed and the new renewal month. As a courtesy, renewal notices will be mail to you and posted on the DLLC website sixty (60) days prior to the due date. By submitting your renewal application and payment by the new deadline, you will not experience a lapse in license status or late fees.
